- C. USATF Annual Meeting: Patti Petesch. They are planning on an in-person meeting in Orlando Dec 1-5. Email Patti if you plan on going.

#### IV COMMITTEE REPORTS

- A. Youth: Holly Genest.
  - 1. Association Championship had 215 athletes. We only had 10 developmental meets prior to this. None had more than 150 athletes.

- 2. Only half the clubs renewed this year due to venue or COVID hassles. JO Nationals is in Sacramento next year so they will probably renew for that.
- 3. Lots of challenges with age verification.
- 4. Lots of challenges with the membership gap because nobody signed up last year, so this year, the system put them in as unattached.
- 5. 15-18 year olds compete this weekend. 214 entries so far.
- 6. First XC meet is Sep 25. There are 4 developmental meets scheduled. Nov 13 Association and Nov 20 Regional are looking at Chambers Bay. Nationals is Dec 11 in Kentucky.
- B. Open: no report.
- C. MUT: Trisha Steidl.
  - 1. We had a problem with course markings at a recent road race.
  - 2. USA 50K Championship list of qualifiers has gotten way bigger recently.
  - 3. Joe Gray won Mt. Washington race.
  - 4. Grayson Murphy, a MUT runner, qualified for finals in the Steeplechase at USAs.
- D. Masters: George Mathews.
  - 1. Open/Masters Association/Regional has 78 entries so far.
  - 2. National Throws Championship is Aug 21/22 at West Seattle Stadium. Capped at 84 plus 72 Ultra.
  - 3. We had 6 Hammer series meets. We did better than break even due to attendance. There were some very good performances.
  - 4. Washington State Hammer Championship was on the 13<sup>th</sup>. We had 21 athletes. Normally we have between 40 and 50. Association Hammer was held at the same time. George had planned to honor long-time hammer promoter and meet director, Dwight Midles, but he was ill and could not attend. George mailed him a plaque acknowledging years of service to the hammer event in Washington State.
  - 5. Brock Eager placed 6<sup>th</sup> in Hammer at USATF Nationals
  - 6. Open/Masters Road championship is July 4 at Magnuson Park with prize money for Open and Masters.
- E. Race Walk: Katie Burnett.
  - 1. JOs had 6 walkers compete
  - 2. We really need RW officials. There is a RW officiating video from Oregon Assn that had good reviews.
  - 3. Katie is injured and is not competing at Trials.
- F. Athletes: Becca Peter.
  - 1. American Track League is planning a meet on Wed Aug 18, maybe at UW. It is run by Paul Doyle and Jesse Williams.
  - 2. Paul Merca has a website of local athletes at the Trials. We have 12 Youth alumni competing.
- G. Coaches: no report.
- H. Officials: Geof Newing.
  - 1. We are done with HS. We timed 3 or 4 events a week. We are getting XC requests from those who saw how easy our bib chips work.
  - 2. Brooks Meet is July 2 at Renton.
  - 3. Too many gaps in the JO schedule last weekend. I hope we can fix it this weekend.
- I. Officials Training & Certification: Bob Springer.
  - 1. National Office outsourced the officials' badges. We finally have about 2/3 of them.
  - 2. We may have an October clinic. We have a number of people looking for a clinic.
- J. SafeSport: Becca Peter.
  - 1. They have a new presentation which is basically a repeat of the old one. They are not getting inputs from constituent groups.
  - 2. They are updating the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy.
  - 3. Membership system is still a nightmare. It affected the Olympic Trials.
  - 4. Patti says we need an earlier notification when you are expiring.
- K. Communications: no report. Melita has a list of 5 website items that need fixing.
- L. Associations Admin: Patti Petesch. Thank you to everyone who was at JOs this weekend.
