Meet Schedule Races start at the times below. Your age group is your age as of 12/31/2024. Distances are approximate. Course walkthrough at 10:00am 1 km 10:45 6 & under 11 & 12 girls 3 km 12:30 11:00 7 & 8 girls 2 km 1:00 11 & 12 boys 3 km 7 & 8 boys 2 km 1:30 13-14/15-18 girls 4 km 11:15 11:30 9 & 10 girls 3 km 2:00 13-14/15-18 boys 4 km 12:00 9 & 10 boys 3 km 2:30 Open/Relay 2.8 km

Notes for 2024 Meet:

- The courses are the same as 2023 (except for the Open/Relay race—see below); note that the meet is on Sunday instead of Saturday.
- 13-14 and 15-18 athletes will run together (one race for girls, one race for boys) but will be scored separately.

New for 2024: Open/Relay Race

- Final race of the day
- o 3 laps of the smallest loop for a distance of approximately 2.8k
- Runners can run all three laps individually or organize relay teams of two or three runners.
- o The exchange zone will be at the start line:
 - We will have a small number of slap bracelets for relay teams to exchange
 - Relay teams may also bring their own baton/scrunchy/etc. or just slap hands
- This is a fun/participatory race:
 - No entry fee but all entrants must register on Athletic.net to complete the waiver. (There is no need to indicate relay vs open status or relay positions when registering for this race on Athletic.net.)
 - Athletes from earlier races can compete again in this race.
 - No ribbons/medals
 - No lap splits for relay teams.
 - We will record relay times using the name of the final leg runner for relays (open times will also be recorded).
